

Questions for Congressional Candidates

1. What actions will you take to preserve American democracy? Address the following:
 - Russian attacks on the 2016 election and preventing attacks on future elections
 - Attacks on the press
 - Threats to jail political opponents
 - Absence of transparency by the President in regard to business dealings with Russia and other possible financial conflicts
 - Refusal by the President to implement sanctions on Russia passed by Congress

2. What actions will you take regarding environmental issues? Address the following:
 - Offshore drilling
 - Paris Climate Accord
 - The changing focus of the EPA
 - The value of collecting and preserving climate science data
 - The protection of wetlands and nationally owned parks, forests, and monuments

3. What actions will you take to reduce gun violence? Address the following:
 - Gun safety measures, including assault weapons, bump stocks, large capacity magazines, and hand guns
 - Mental and emotional health
 - Background checks
 - Gun safety research
 - Accepting donations from the NRA
 - Providing guns to teachers

4. Describe your position on immigration reform. Address the following:
 - Policies related to the Dreamers
 - Restrictions on numbers of immigrants entering the country
 - Restrictions on country of origin
 - Policies related to immigration enforcement
 - Border security

5. What will you do to improve the quality and reduce the cost of healthcare? Address the following:
 - Obamacare
 - Single payer
 - Prescription drugs
 - For-profit system
 - Medicare, Medicaid, and CHIP
 - Preventative care
