

# Relational Voter Program List-Building Worksheet

## How to get started

## A word about your list

These are your people. People you already know well, and folks you'd like to know better. The purpose of this list is to help you start thinking about the people in your life you can have conversations with. Once you make a list and start having conversations, you'll see the snowball effect that this type of organizing can have.

## Tips:

Cast a wide net – even if you think someone always votes or is already engaged, put them on the list. Maybe they would be willing to make their own lists and talk to their networks!

Include family members, neighbors, friends from work, friends from high school, people from church, parents of your kids' friends. Scroll through your phone – think of it as brainstorming. You don't have to contact every person you put on your list.

Remember that this is *your* list – you're the only person who will contact your people. We can match people in the voter file to find out how likely they are to vote (and whether they're registered to vote!) and how likely they are to be liberal. This will help you decide how to prioritize your conversations and how to approach different people.
